### REPUBLICAN PRIMARY PREVIEW

Every two years in March of even numbered years, Republicans face off in the Republican Primary Election for the right to face the Democrat in the November General Election. These are the hardest elections for Republicans because there or often two or more qualified candidates of extremely similar ideology. They tend to mostly be good or even great candidates. Separating them can come down to the slightest of differences. In other races, although still difficult, the decision is easier. This season, TCR has issued an unprecedented number of early endorsements because in some races the candidates are the clear choice in our opinion. That doesn't mean that the other candidate is necessarily bad, it just means we see that one is obviously superior. In other races, the verdict has yet to be returned, and the research will continue until our editorial team is confident in our choice.

#### **U.S. SENATE**

Senator John Cornyn is facing his first serious Republican challenge since his election in 2002 and will square off with Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton and Congressman Wesley Hunt (CD-38) in March. **Hunt** is a relatively late entry to the contest that had raged for months between Cornyn and Paxton. Based on this field, TCR believes that Cornyn is the right choice for conservatives. Paxton is a non-starter for TCR due to his serial marital infidelity that led to Senator Angela Paxton divorcing him on "Biblical grounds." TCR is of the opinion that if a candidate's wife can't trust him, voters shouldn't. We consider Hunt a distraction who cannot gain enough traction in a contest that has been underway for months.

#### **CONGRESSIONAL SEATS**

(in and around Harris County)

Congressman **Dan Crenshaw** has drawn a serious challenge this cycle from State Rep **Steve Toth** for the CD-2 seat that former Navy SEAL **Dan Crenshaw** has held since his election in 2018.



TCR is issuing an early endorsement for State Senator Mayes Middleton due to his solid conservative record in the Texas House and Senate and for his executive experience in the private sector. Middleton's leadership on many issues has left no doubt regarding his conservative bona fides. He has led countless fights, taking on the radical left, and winning.

Unlike Crenshaw, his Navy
SEAL brother-in-arms Morgan
Luttrell unexpectedly announced
he will not seek re-election to his
CD-8 seat. Announced candidates
include Jessica Hart Steinmann
and Army combat veteran Nick
Tran. Steinmann has racked up an
impressive list of endorsements
and will be hard to beat.

Thanks to the new congressional maps passed by Governor **Abbott** and the Texas Legislature, we have a

newly drawn Republican Congressional District 9. The two main contenders for this one are conservative
State Representative Briscoe Cain and Alexandra Mealer, who ran unsuccessfully for Harris County
Judge in 2022. TCR recommends a vote for Briscoe Cain who has proven himself in the legislative trenches as a true and committed conservative.
TCR also likes the fact that Cain has a history in the district and lives there, while Mealer does not.

In another unexpected announcement, Congressman Michael McCaul will leave behind his CD-10 seat. No candidates for this one have emerged yet but surely will for this coveted seat. The 38th Congressional seat will also be open now that incumbent Wesley Hunt has entered the U.S. Senate race. The announced candidates are Jon Bonck, Shelly de Zavallos, and Barrett McNabb.

### ATTORNEY GENERAL

The decision by A.G. Paxton to challenge Senator John Cornyn leaves a vacancy in the office. The field for this one quickly became crowded with the entry of Congressman Chip Roy, State Senators Joan Huffman and Mayes Middleton, and attorney Aaron Reitz. TCR is issuing an early endorsement for State Senator Mayes Middleton due to his solid conservative record in the Texas House and Senate and for his executive experience in the private sector. Middleton's leadership on many issues has left no doubt regarding his conservative bona fides. He has led countless fights, taking on the radical left, and winning. Most recently, his work passing S.B. 8, the bill that he authored, means that Texas will have the strongest Women's Privacy Act in America to protect our wives and daughters.

### COMPTROLLER OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTS

This is an open seat due to Glenn Hegar's resignation on July 1, 2025, to become chancellor of Texas A & M University. Candidates for the office include acting Comptroller Kelly Hancock. State Senator Don Huffines and Railroad Commissioner Christi Craddick. After reviewing the field, TCR is making an early endorsement for Don Huffines for Texas Comptroller. Don Huffines is a proven conservative with an impressive platform. Huffines has pledged to bring DOGE to Texas—exposing waste, fraud, and abuse in government to increase efficiency and put every penny into property tax relief. As a state senator, Huffines never accepted a penny of compensation for his public service and states that he will not accept a salary if elected Comptroller. Huffines is a proven MAGA conservative and Trump ally. He has been endorsed by Ted Cruz, Charlie Kirk, Jim "Mattress Mack" McIngvale" and every major conservative organization in the state. TCR believes that we need more patriots like **Don Huffines** leading Texas.

### AGRICULTURE COMMISSIONER

Incumbent Ag Commissioner Sid Miller will face challenger Nate Sheets in March. Sheets is a former donor to Miller but has his own ideas for the office.

## STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, DISTRICT 6

Incumbent Will Hickman has not endeared himself to conservatives and drawn their ire and at least one challenger, Tiffany Nelson, who has been endorsed by SBOE member Julie Pickren and State Representative Valoree Swanson among others.

#### STATE REPRESENTATIVE

Last month, beloved State Representative **Sam Harless** announced that he would not seek re-election to his House District 126 seat. Announced candidates for the now-open seat include former Harris County Clerk Stan Stanart, Polly Looper and Harless District Director Kelly Peterson. Stan Stanart is a solid conservative who did an outstanding job as Harris County Clerk and has earned our recommendation as the next State Representative for District 126.

Two candidates have announced their intention to succeed Briscoe Cain in the House District 128 contest. The names in that race are former Harris County School Trustee Michael Wolfe and Tom Butler who is President of USI Federal Credit Union in La Porte.

When State Senator Mayes
Middleton declared his candidacy for
Attorney General, State Representative
Dennis Paul announced for
Middleton's SD-11 seat (TCR is joining
President Trump and Lt. Gov. Patrick
and issuing an early endorsement for

Dennis), leaving his House District 129 seat up for grabs. Upon the announcement, Clear Creek ISD board member and grassroots activist **Scott Bowen** threw his hat into the ring as did **Bob Mitchell**, former president of the Bay Area Houston Economic Partnership (BAHEP).

### **HARRIS COUNTY JUDGE**

Republicans are lining up for another bite at the apple to become Harris County's chief executive. Four years ago, Alexandra Mealer lost by 20,000 votes. Republicans hope to bridge the gap in 2026. The heavyweights in the race include former Harris County Treasurer Orlando Sanchez, Firefighters Union boss Marty Lancton and Piney Point Mayor Aliza Dutt. The victor of the Republican Primary will face off with the Democrat which will likely be former Houston Mayor Annise Parker or Houston City Councilmember Letitia Plummer.

### HARRIS COUNTY COMMISSIONER

Lining up for the opportunity to square off against Democrat Adrian Garcia in Precinct 2 are Pastor Richard Vega and businesswoman Raquel Hernandez-Boujourne. Former Commissioner Steve Radack has announced that he will challenge Commissioner Lesley Briones for the Precinct 4 seat. So far, Radack is unopposed.

### A FEW FINAL ENDORSEMENTS

In the Harris County
Republican Party Chair race, TCR
is endorsing incumbent Cindy
Siegel for re-election over her
challenger, Michelle Bouchard.

Other early endorsements include Todd Frankfort for Justice, 1st Court of Appeals, Place 3, Jessica Caird for Justice, 1st Court of Appeals, Place 5, Chris Daniel for Harris County District Clerk and Marc Cowart for Harris County Treasurer. Daniel and Cowart are currently unopposed.

I recently saw something that made me do a double take. It was an ad for Houston City Council candidate **Dwight Boykins** that showed many prominent Republicans supporting his campaign. It included former Houston City Councilmembers **Mike Sullivan**, **Dr. Jack Christie**, **Dave Martin** and **Anne Clutterbuck**. These are conservatives who know what it takes to do the job, and they think **Boykins** would be the best from the field of 14 candidates.

It also included current Council
Members Willie Davis and Twila
Carter (whom TCR supported in
their campaigns). This is important
because they are currently doing the
job as conservatives on Houston City
Council and asking for voters to send
them another ally who can back them

up on critical infrastructure votes. They want **Boykins** as that ally.

Other conservative notables included former State Representative Dan Huberty (Kingwood), former HCC Trustee Mills Worsham and Ericka McCrutcheon, who was elected to HCAD Director, Place 4. These political pros know that we must vote for an experienced leader who can "hit the ground running," which Boykins can, since he previously served six years on Council. They are also pragmatic enough to know that, in deep blue Houston, the candidate must be able to forge coalitions across political and racial boundaries. They recognize that a Republican Party-endorsed candidate just can't win in a city as blue as Houston. A campaign and a

candidate that performs well in bright red Senate District 7 is dead-on-arrival in a City of Houston, At-Large 4 race.

Finally, the endorsement that blew my socks off was Harris County Commissioner Tom Ramsey. This one is so important because Ramsey, a county commissioner and accomplished engineer, understands the infrastructure needs of our area—flooding, drainage, construction, and roads and bridges, to name a few—and he puts his trust in Dwight Boykins to lead on critical infrastructure needs. In this race, his endorsement is good enough for me. It should be good enough for you, which is why I and TCR recommend a vote for Dwight Boykins for Houston City Council, At-Large, Position 4 this November. \*


